

Licensing agreement between the World Subud Association and Subud Publications International.

It is first established and agreed that the World Subud Association (WSA), 4101 Legation Street, N.W., Washington, CD 20015 USA, hereafter known as the Licensor, owns the entire copyright for all works of the late Bapak Muhammad Subuh Sumohadwidjojo, hereafter known as the Author. Be these works in written, Audio or Video format, in Indonesian, English or any other language that they have been translated into.

It is secondly established and agreed that the name Subud and the Seven Circles Symbol are registered marks of the Licensor

It is further established that the use of the name Subud and the Seven Circles Symbol can be granted by the Licensor to anyone asking to use it, under certain conditions.

Due to the fact that: The Constitutions of the WSA and SPI are available to both parties and show that it is not possible to have an enforceable legal relationship between the two organisations, hence the establishment of this licensing agreement which can be removed by WSA from SPI at any moment, if certain conditions are not fulfilled.

It is also established that SPI is directly accountable to the WSA Executive Body.

The Licensor hereby grants the publishing and distribution rights of all the Authors works in written, audio and video format to:

Hereafter known as the Publisher.

This licence hereby cancels the agreement signed in 1997 between the then ISC chairman Harun Murray and SPI and any other agreement that could be found to exist.

This Licence is given for publishing and distribution of the Indonesian and English together. At this point the main project of SPI is the Bapak Volume Project. Any other books or authors, for whom the World Subud Association has the copyright, shall be the object of a separate agreement.

The Expectations of the Licensor concerning the Bapak Volume project are the following:

- 1.a) Preparation of approximately 50/60 new authorised English Translations, the equivalent of 3 volumes a year.
- 1.b) The printing and distribution of at least 2 volumes per year, in formats ensuring maximum distribution e.g. volumes, on the net, single talk versions.

1.c) Ensuring that the relevant documents, in DVD format, are made available to the **official translation teams**, designated by WSA Executive on behalf of the Licensor. Further than that the Publisher has no responsibility concerning the translations of the Authors Volumes.

1.d) Maintaining an available stock of the Volumes for distribution.

1.e) Furnishing WSA with an annual budget and financial statement and to make available any financial information needed.

Furthermore in exchange of the publishing rights granted, the Publisher agrees to:

2) Print on the appropriate page, as well as on the jackets and packaging of audio and video/DVD product: Copyright© 200X, World Subud Association. All rights reserved. No part of this publication may be reproduced, stored in a retrieval system, or transmitted in any form or by any means, electrical, mechanical, photocopying, recording or otherwise, without the written permission of the publisher.

3.a) Place the ® logo next to the Seven Circles Symbol and the name Subud on the inside title of any book and on stationary and any other company promotional materials, with the mention (at least once):

'Subud' and the seven circles symbol are registered marks of the World Subud Association.

3. b) Put the ® and same mention on the jacket and packaging of all audio, video or DVD product.

4. a) Submit any requests from third parties, to use extracts or entire talks or any other work of the Authors for publishing in any form, to the Licensor. Once accepted the Publisher must ensure that a written agreement is signed between themselves and the third party, defining in which way and under what conditions (including financially) they can use the extracts or talks of the author. These conditions must be agreed with the Licensor.

4.b) The Publisher can authorise a third party to use quotes from the Author's talks or works under the conditions that the exact reference of the specific talk or work is cited and also that the following mention appears clearly:

The statements and opinions included in these pages do not necessarily reflect those of the World Subud Association, a 501 (c) 3 non profit organization registered in the US state of Virginia - its officers, affiliates, or members.

Quotations from all copyrighted material owned by the World Subud Association may or may not be accurate.

5) The Publisher will supply the Licensor with a list of all other Subud books or Subud related books for which they have the publishing rights.

In exchange the Licensor agrees to:

6) In principle the licensors accepts full responsibility for the funding of the English translations of the Bapak's talks project. However in recognition of the varying annual income of WSA SPI agrees to use its fundraising expertise to raise top-up money as and when required.

7) Use the organisational communication line to raise awareness of the importance and availability of the Bapak Volumes Project.

REMUNERATION: To date, the publications and distribution of Bapak's talks, the Volumes Project, has been a non profit operation. It is agreed between the parties that if this should change at any point, they will negotiate remuneration on a royalty basis, in good faith.
