WSA's CARE SUPPORT PROGRAM

WHAT IS IT?

WSA's Care Support helps and cares for the needs of Subud members all over the world. We do this by giving one time grants of money to help Subud members through a difficult time in their lives and by supporting members' education with small grants.

The Emergency Fund exists to help members in need for their personal lives due to unfortunate circumstances such as the loss of a job or health problems and also to help members who suffer loss in natural disasters like earthquakes, drought or war.

Many countries have their own Care Support funds or Almoner groups. The Emergency fund exists especially, but not exclusively, for those countries which are not able to set up their own fund.

The Education Fund provides grants and bursaries for Subud members or the children of Subud members for education at any level from primary to post-graduate.

HOW TO APPLY

If you need help, or know someone who you think could be helped in this way, please get in touch with us. The first step is to test with your local helpers to see if this is a good idea. You do not have to tell your local helpers about your circumstances if you do not want to, and the application process is in the strictest confidence. Testing is an essential part of the process and the Care Support Team must check that this test has been done. If the answer is to go ahead, you can contact the team by sending a completed application form by post or email.
