QUESTIONS and ANSWERS

1. *Can I apply for a Subud Education fund scholarship?*

Yes, if you are a Subud member or you are younger than 17 and your parents are Subud members AND you are not able to afford an education.

2. *Can the Fund finance my entire costs?*

We expect you to tap other resources – please don't rely on this a single source of income. We have more applications than we have funding for.

3. *How do I show need?*

Please describe, in your personal letter of intent, your financial situation that prevents you from completing or starting out on an educational program.

4. *How do I show merit?*

By including copies of a recent report card or progress report (elementary and secondary school), transcripts (from K – 12, and/or post secondary institutions); or other document that describes what you are doing; your letters of reference describe your abilities.

5. *Can parents apply on behalf of a child?*

Yes - If the child is in elementary & secondary school.

We encourage the applicant to apply on her/his behalf for post secondary schooling or programs – vocational school, art school, technical college, agricultural school, community college, university and so on.

6. *How many applications can one family submit?*

Just one per family as our funding is limited. Please choose the highest priority of need of the family to make a decision on one application

7. *Can I apply to go to England if I live in Peru?*

For the time being, if you live in Peru you can apply only for consideration in Peru. That is, you can apply for scholarship support only in the country where you live.

8. *How can the scholarship help me?*

- with registration and tuition costs

- with costs of books and supplies
- with uniform or shoes and other clothing for elementary or secondary school with living expenses if you are away from home
OR
- Help with living expenses if you live at home and cannot work during the period of your program.

9. *If I am awarded a scholarship, what period of time does it cover?*

It covers one year.

10. *Can I apply again for another year?*

Yes.

11. *How much is the award?*

We advertised the awards as being either \$500 or \$1000. However, based on a case by case basis, we will decide on smaller awards between \$100 - \$500 as well.

12. *How do I prove I am registered at the institution I have put on my application?*

Include in your application, a photocopy of the receipt for registration OR a letter from your institution showing you have been accepted into the program OR in the case of K – 12 children, provide the name of the school the child is attending.

- An application form
- Transcripts or documents showing current status
- A personal letter of intent
- A budget
- A letter from a Subud member
- Two reference letters
