2010 Subud World Subud Congress COUNTRY REPORT

NAME of COUNTRY	Argentina
GENERAL FACTS such as number of members and groups	Buenos Aires---25 active members Mina Clavero ---4 active members Isolated members in Rosario, Bariloche, and Tucuman About 35 members in total
GENERAL CHANGES in the last four years	In 2007 due to the resignation of the national helper, a general discussion began about the fact that some members and helpers were moving away from the groups and doing latihan outside of them.
IMPORTANT EVENTS in your country since 2005	On April 16, 2009 we celebrated 50 years of Subud in Argentina. This coincides with Bapak's first visit to the country, but the group had actually started in January of 1959 when Meredith Starr visited. On May 16, 2009 in Buenos Aires we also celebrated the 50th anniversary of our oldest helper, Valentin Smith, who continues as an active local helper.
WORK OF NATIONAL COMMITTEE in the last four years	The work of the National committee has been regular and stable these last 4 years; National congresses have been organized and carried out annually. In the 2007 National Congress it was decided to do without the activity of the Wings although in this year's congress there was talk of the possibility of reforming them.
HIGHLIGHTS of MEMBERS' PROJECTS	In Mina Clavero a helper continues with her NGO whose goal is to help in the development of rural schools in the zone. There are other members who have their own activities in the areas of theatre, arts, health, etc
IMPORTANT OBJECTIVES and HOPES for the future	One of our goals for the futures in the reincorporation of members who have dropped out.
NATIONAL FINANCES	In general, the national helpers and the chair cover their own travel expenses except in some cases when the group has contributed. Our major expense is the annual presentation of our financial status to the authorities which has been done regularly the last 34 years.
