

WSHPP Draft Resolution v2

In line with the spirit of the 2010 World Congress resolution 10, the WSC agrees that MSF can invest up to USD 800,000 in the purchase of key properties in Wisma Subud from the Bapak Legacy Fund so long as the following conditions are met:

- There are matching funds from GHFP or other donors
- That the MSF has been legally recognised at the founder with full responsibility for the assets of YMS and YS at the time of purchase.
- Ownership of the newly purchased properties is vested in a new Yayasan in which MSF will be a founding member or in a joint Yayasan comprising YMS and YS with MSF as its Founder.
- WSA is not asked to donate operating funds in the management of Wisma Subud.
- A concept paper is completed based upon which a feasibility study is produced by the designated sub-committee of WSHPP chaired by Subud International Cultural Association' chair for the integral use of the key properties in Wisma Subud (and Bapak's two houses) which allows the site to be self-supporting and which meets the criteria developed in earlier papers on the subject: a framework for the concept paper for WSHPP dated 28<sup>th</sup> April 2012.
- In conjunction with the WSA, and based upon (5) above, master plan is drawn up by WSHPP (including YS and YMS and other stakeholders) to the local authorities and attempts are made to gain national heritage protection for the WS site and for the 2 Bapak houses.
