<b>IMPRESSIONS</b> Please report on the most important aspects of your trips.	<b>Singapore</b> surprised us with a turn out of about 16 men and 6 ladies for Latihan, far more than we expected. Latihan was good and we conducted a few testing questions. <b>Colombo</b> was a good turn out, many older experienced members and a sprinkling of younger ones. <b>Bangalore</b> was preparing a national congress and we joined a large enthusiastic gathering of over a hundred members. Judy reported that a lot of progress had been made in the latihan over the 4 years and the membership is growing. We travelled to <b>Thalle</b> ; a village where the Sradha project was based and met with about 80 villagers. We gave a brief explanation of Subud to a group of women, 5 of whom were applicants and 2 candidate helpers.
<b>DEWAN MEETINGS</b> Any information you care to share about meeting among yourselves this past year.	Our Dewan has only met together at the Congress in Christchurch.  We all, except An Dien, met in Colombo and Bangalore at least once a day.  Mainly focussing on the means to work together and team building to foster a close and harmonious feeling.
<b>CONDITIONS</b> Have impressions of your Area changed, and if so, how?	Being the first visit for most of us as IH's we were not able to compare.  We did have useful help and input from Robert Goonetilleke in Sri Lanka and from Judy Gibb in India. Also Asmaniah Fraval had provided us with a comprehensive report before we left.
